

Our Environmental Improvement Plan 2016/2017

1. Reduce waste to landfill

- Maintain public recycling on site for paper, plastic and batteries
- Monitor effectiveness of new waste station in kitchen
- Continued use of recycled or responsibly sourced office materials

2. Reduce transport use

- Reduce centre mileage
- Economical driving training for new staff
- Update local venues guide for instructional activities

3. Reduce energy use

- Utilisation of LE lamps
- Inclusion of energy saving systems in proposed site development plans
- Upgrade of exterior lighting to include LE lamps and PIR
- Upgrade to PIR lighting in appropriate areas

4. Reduce water use

- Install water savers into toilets where applicable
- Install spray taps where applicable

5. Raise Awareness

- Display current EM Plan, Green Dragon Certificate and DEC in the centre
- Maintain Green Dragon certification
- Introduce new Green Working Group

6. Prevent Pollution

- Audit all departmental use of chemicals, assess environmental impact
- Identify harmful chemicals in Task 1
- Reinstate colour coding of drains
